

The Looper - Downtown St. Petersburg's Trolley

Description of Stops & Timetable

Departures noted by minutes past each hour in () between 11:00 and 4:30

- 1 - THE PIER** - Five stories of interesting shops, aquarium, food court, restaurants and a variety of entertainment. Trolleys depart on the hour and half hour and arrive back at The Pier at :25 and :55 minutes past each hour after making a "loop" around the city's downtown area. (:00/:30)
- 2 - ST. PETERSBURG MUSEUM OF HISTORY** - Features a full-size replica of the Benoist airboat that started commercial aviation worldwide. (:02/:32)
- 3 - MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS/BEACH DRIVE RETAIL DISTRICT** - Museum is featuring the special exhibition The Lure of Egypt: Land of the Pharaohs Revisited. The Beach Drive shopping precinct is home to art galleries, restaurants and boutiques. (:03/:33)
- 4 - RENAISSANCE VINOY RESORT/P. BUCKLEY MOSS GALLERY** - The Vinoy is a full service luxury resort with a golf course, tennis complex, marina, 5 restaurants and 2 lounges. P. Buckley Moss Gallery is home to the largest collection of works by the artist. (:06/:36)
- 5 - PLAZA TOWER AND COURTYARD SHOPS** - This large office complex also features restaurants and retail shopping. **CHAMBER OF COMMERCE WELCOME CENTER** is adjacent to the tower. **REQUEST STOP ONLY** (:08/:38)
- 6 - FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL MUSEUM/JANNUS LANDING RETAIL AND RESTAURANT DISTRICT** - Splendors of Ancient Egypt art exhibition and International Cafe in the Museum Lobby. Many fine restaurants and art galleries are centered around Jannus Landing which is located around Central Avenue and Second Street. (:10/:40)
- 7 - FOURTH AND CENTRAL** - This popular intersection features restaurants, retail shopping and is home to many downtown office buildings. Stop also services **JEFF'S DESSERTS** at Third and Central. **REQUEST STOP ONLY** (:12/:42)
- 8 - GREAT EXPLORATIONS** - Exciting hands-on exhibits in the arts, science and health for all ages. (:14/:44)
- 9 - SALVADOR DALI MUSEUM** - Home to the world's most comprehensive collection of works by the Spanish surrealist. (:15/:45)
- 10 - USF/AIRPORT/CRUISE PORT** - Bayboro campus of the University of South Florida, Albert Whited Airport and the St. Petersburg Cruise Port. **REQUEST STOP ONLY** (:17/:47)
- 11 - BAYFRONT HILTON HOTEL** - Featuring swimming pool and fitness center plus a choice of casual and fine dining. Also featuring **PIZZA HUT**. This stop also serves the nearby Al Lang Stadium, Bayfront Center and Mahaffey Theatre. (:19/:49)
- 12 - BARNETT TOWER/MCNULTY STATION** - Featuring restaurants and retail, this stop also serves several major office buildings in the area. **REQUEST STOP ONLY** (:21/:51)

FARES - This is a free trolley service. It is brought to you by our valued sponsors and advertisers who are indicated in bold type on the route information.

WHERE TO CATCH THE LOOPER - Looper stops are marked by special pink Looper signs at the locations on the route information panel. Please signal driver at **REQUEST STOPS** which trolleys do not automatically stop at.

HOURS OF OPERATION - Seven days a week from 11 am until 5 pm. Trolleys do not operate on Thanksgiving or Christmas.

CHARTER INFORMATION - The Loopers are available for charter during off-hours. For information, call 813/571-3440.

OWNER/OPERATOR - The Loopers are operated on behalf of The Looper Group, Inc., a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization, by Carey Limousine. Donations are kindly accepted and are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law.

FREQUENCY - The Loopers run every 30 minutes throughout the city connecting the most popular attractions and hotels with the city's retail and restaurant districts as well as the major employers. The Loopers are convenient for visitors and residents. Park once and visit the entire downtown area. Office workers can hop a Looper for lunch or get to a meeting in another part of the city without having to worry about parking. All stops have restaurants nearby.

CONNECTIONS - The Looper stops at several locations where convenient connections exist to other transportation systems, including the Pinellas Suncoast Transit Authority, Albert Whitted Airport, several marinas, as well as the Cruise Port.
